

ESSEX HEIGHTS PRIMARY SCHOOL SLEEPOVER AND CERES EXCURSION

The Year 4 Essex Heights Sleepover and CERES excursion is an overnight and full day experience that the students will thoroughly enjoy. The children will participate in a range of activities which will foster resilience, independent learning and a study of Sustainability.

Our excursion begins at 5.30pm on Thursday 7th September with a BBQ dinner (sausages, bread, salad, cordial drink and fresh fruit) at Essex Heights Primary School, followed with games (co-operative games) and activities (sing-a-long and skits) in the stadium. At 9.00pm, the children will be organised into their sleeping quarters in the Violet Building (V4 and V3 for the girls and V1 and V2 for the boys).

At 7am, the students will have breakfast (toast, vegemite, jam, margarine and fruit juice). At 8.30am we will board a seat-belted bus for **CERES** (Centre for Education and Research in Environmental Strategies) on the Corner of Roberts and Stewart Streets, Brunswick East, 3057.
