NAPLAN indicates that students growth needs to be a focus in literacy, especially reading and writing. Also NAPLAN numeracy growth is an area that needs to be addressed. This could be a focus of this year as an introduction to our new SSP. SATSS data shows that more effective teaching practoce must be a focus. The SATSS data suggests that student engagement in their classroom still needs to improve so we must continue to implement our instructional model using the resources of the 'Hattie' team at University of Melbourne to focus on improving professional practice (learning intentions, sucess criteria and feedback).
